Maths

We will be learning about numbers to 100. We will:

- Add and subtract numbers to 20.
- To find 10 more or 10 less than a number.
- To add or subtract a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number.
- To add and subtract two 2-digit numbers.
- To learn about making an exchange when adding or subtracting.
- Identify and describe the properties of 3D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces.
- Identify 2D shapes on the surface of 3D shapes, [for example, a circle on a cylinder and a triangle on a pyramid].
