



Dear Families,

This half term our topic learning will continue to focus on animals as we learn to answer questions such as 'Are eggs alive?' and 'Which animals hatch from eggs?'. The children will learn where birds live and what they need to survive. We will learn about the lifecycle of a chick and find out which other types of animals come from eggs. We will then explore animals of the past as we learn about Dinosaurs and how they too came from eggs. Our egg theme will continue as Easter approaches and we will learn to answer questions such as 'Why do some people give eggs at Easter?'

It is also useful for our Nursery children to have a bag so that letters, artwork and library books can be transported home safely.

Please ensure that your child brings a spare set of clothing into school, particularly Hedgehogs (Nursery Children). If your child has borrowed any spare clothing from school please can you ensure that they are washed and then returned to school as our supplies are running low. If your child has outgrown any trousers, socks or underwear, donations of these would be gratefully received.
