Dear Families,

I hope that you and the children had a lovely Easter break and are ready for a new term filled with learning and fun.

This half term our learning will centre around lifecycles and growing as we answer the questions 'How does your garden grow?'. We will begin by learning what seeds need to grow and plant our own seeds, observing them as they grow. We will explore whether all seeds look the same as we chop up variety of fruits and vegetables to observe and draw what we find inside. Other learning questions we will discover answers to this half term include 'How do we know plants are alive?', 'Why are bees important?', 'How do worms help us?', 'How do butterflies change as they grow?' and 'What can we do to help look after plants and insects?'.

Reception families, please support your child to read their reading book with you at least three times a week and sign the reading record each time you have read with your child. Reading books will be taken in on Thursdays and a new one will be sent home on Fridays.

Please label children's clothing/shoes with their names. We have lots of clothing, accessories and wellies in our cloakroom that remain unclaimed. Throughout the first week back these items will be taken outside at home time please collect anything that belongs to your child.

Toys

Last half term there were lots of toys coming into school and many were getting damaged or lost and it can be very difficult to ensure all toys return home with the correct child. Please encourage your child to leave their toys safely at home.
