### How can you help?

Below is a list of ongoing activities you may find useful to help you revise and consolidate what the children have learned so far in Year 2.

#### Maths

Learning off by heart pairs of numbers that make 10, 20, or 100 - e.g. 3+7, 3+17 and 30+70.

Multiplication and division - counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and writing number sentences:

e.g.  $3 \times 5 = 15$  or  $15 \div 3 = 5$

Telling the time – o'clock, half past, to the quarter of an hour or to five minutes.

#### English

Practice spellings wherever possible to help improve writing.

Use punctuation correctly, including capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks.

Read books and answer questions about their understanding of what they have read.

#### P.E.

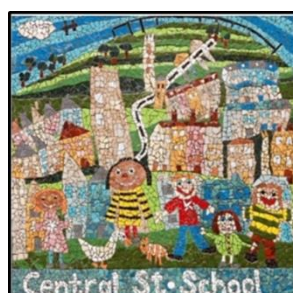
Please ensure your child has their full PE kit in school as soon as possible and all items are named.
