Valley

Valley Class have been learning to answer the question 'What might you see in the Arctic?'. They have learnt where the Arctic is and what the climate is like, thinking about the clothes and equipment they might need to wear to keep warm. They have learnt which animals live in the Arctic and learnt about the lives of some of the Inuit's who live in the Arctic, comparing life in the Arctic to their own in Hebden Bridge.



River

This month we have been learning all about the amazing animals around the world and where they live. We have been having a real focus on colour and pattern in art and exploring life cycles and habitat in science and geography. There has also been some great individual work in communication and a real focus on perfecting our handwriting and letter formation. Well done everyone in River Class!



Woodland

Woodland Class have had had a busy start to our new topic. In Art we have been learning about the work of a folk artist, Heather Galler. Her art is bright and colourful and the children really like her "lollipop trees." We looked at one of her cityscapes and compared it to the houses we've seen in Hebden Bridge. We've learnt to use wax crayons to make a resist for some bright watercolours to create our own Hebden landscapes in the style of the artist.



Moorland

Moorland class had a great start to the new term. We have started to learn about multiplication and have been finding what equal groups look like and how to make equal groups of our own.

In music, we have been listening to some rock songs from Queen and Deep Purple to help us learn how to keep a steady beat. We will be using our voice and instrument skills in new song called called 'I Wanna Be In a Band"
