Valley class have been learning about why the festival of Diwali is special to Hindu's and Sikhs and how families celebrate this festival. The children have created fire works pictures and created Diya lamps using clay and salt dough. We learnt that some families decorate their doorsteps with Rangoli patterns, and we created some beautiful Rangoli patterns of our own in the playground. As we learnt about Diwali the children began to make connections with celebrations that they take part in with their own

families.

River class have started the half term learning about some of the many festivals different communities celebrate at this time of year. We started by thinking about Bonfire Night and some of the children shared their personal experiences of seeing and hearing fireworks. The children made their own bonfire representations using paint and straws. We have then looked at images of Diwali and how people celebrate. We have used collaborative drawing and clay models to imagine what these might look like before writing letters and postcards to her.
