P.E

Please can you ensure your child has a full P.E kit in school at all times. It is helpful if this is labelled with your child's name and in a pump bag/small bag so that the kit can be packed away and stored on your child's coat peg at the end of a session. Your child will take part in P.E with River class on Tuesday's and Thursday's. We will change for these sessions.

Some children will also take part in P.E as part of their inclusion opportunities. Kits will be sent home at the end of a half term. Please return, washed, at the start of each term.

Reading books and Library books

We share books with your child during their 1:1 session daily. These books will be sent home for you to share with your child at home. Whilst I appreciate this can be difficult for some children to access at home, if you can share, please let us know by filling in a comment in your child's reading record.

I will also be sending a letter about using our library and borrowing books from the library. This is a lovely way of developing the children's interest in books and making their own choice.

Please do let us know any other books or reading materials your child enjoys at home – it's always lovely to see what they enjoy at home.

Curriculum

A newsletter will be sent out each half term outlining what we are going to be learning during that period.

You will be invited in the next few weeks to meet to discuss your child's ILDP targets for the term. These meetings can be held in person or virtually as required.
